The following Letters Patent were signed by Her Majesty The Queen on the 7th of March 2015 in respect of the Budget (Scotland) (No.4) Bill ASP 2.

ELIZABETH THE SECOND by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories Queen Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament

GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

Searching will be made through PNC only, (although AccessNI will still retain an ability to check Causeway for clarification purposes). It also sets out the details of the information that AccessNI will provide where the individual's criminal record shows he/or she has a restorative caution, a diversionary youth conference order or an informed warning.

Sections 112(3), 113A(3) and 113B(3) of Part V of the Police Act 1997, requires the Minister of Justice to provide information held in central records on criminal conviction, criminal record and enhanced criminal record certificates. Part V also enables the Minister to prescribe central records for this purpose.

Regulation 2(3) sets out details AccessNI will provide in respect of a restorative caution, a diversionary youth conference order or an informed warning and (4) amends the requirement for disclosure of information from Causeway but retain the option for disclosure where appropriate.

These Regulations come into operation on 1st April 2015.
