BELFAST CITY COUNCIL AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA PM10 REVOCATION ORDER 2015

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT BELFAST CITY COUNCIL (hereinafter the Council), pursuant to its powers under the Environment (Northern Ireland) Order 2002, has made the above Order ("the Order").

The effect of the Order shall be to modify the Air Quality Management Order, given under the Corporate Seal of the City of Belfast on 1st July 2004 and which came into effect on 31st August 2004, by the deletion of Area 1 in relation to a breach of the particulate matter objective.

Area 1 incorporates the M1/Westlink corridor from the Belfast City boundary at Sir Thomas and Lady Dixon Park to the end of the Westlink at the junction with Great Georges Street and York Street including Stockmans Lane and Kennedy Way. On 1st July 2004, the Council designated the area as an Air Quality Management Area in relation to a likely breach of certain objectives specified in the Air Quality Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003. Following extensive monitoring, the Council confirms that air quality standards and objectives for particulate matter are being achieved. Management Area 1 shall continue to be designated as an Air Quality Management Area in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide objective.

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development hereby gives notice, in pursuance of Article 12A (3) of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (as amended) that it proposes to carry out a Flood Alleviation Scheme on the Lissue Stream, Lisburn.

Works are proposed to provide Q100 flood protection to several properties in the Hulls Lane area which have experienced flooding in the past and remain at flood risk. The works involve the construction of approximately 50m of conveyance channel, approximately 175m of culvert, approximately 355m of flood embankment and the replacement and upgrade of the Hulls Lane road bridge. This scheme will also allow Coca-Cola HBC to complete works within their own site which will upgrade currently temporary works to a permanent structure which will contribute to the wider flood alleviation scheme for the area.

Having taken account of the characteristics of the works in the proposed scheme, their location and potential impacts, the Department considers the proposed scheme is not likely to have significant environmental effects on the environment and does not intend to prepare an Environmental Statement.

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development hereby gives notice, in pursuance of Article 12A (3) of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (as amended) that it proposes to carry out a drainage scheme on the Taughmonagh Stream, Finaghy, Belfast.

The Taughmonagh Stream is designated and runs for approximately 2.5km from the Upper Malone Road to the Boucher Road, Belfast. The stream flows mainly underground inside culverts. Approximately 600m of culvert between Greystown Avenue and Finnis Drive, Belfast has deteriorated and there have been flood events within the catchment over recent years.

The scheme will construct a new larger diameter culvert at Greystown Avenue, Upper Malone Park, Malfin Drive and Finnis Drive. This will improve the condition of the drainage infrastructure and increase the conveyance capacity of the Taughmonagh Stream.

The new culvert will follow the existing line for approximately 220m from the Upper Malone Road, along Greystown Avenue and across to Upper Malone Park. The culvert will divert from the existing line at Upper Malone Park to run approximately 400m through to, and along Malfin Drive to Finnis Drive. The culvert will turn to run approximately 50m towards Sicily Park, finally turning to run approximately 150m towards Balmoral Golf Course.

Having taken account of the characteristics of the works in the proposed scheme, their location and potential impacts, the Department considers the proposed scheme is not likely to have significant environmental effects on the environment and does not intend to prepare an Environmental Statement.
