THE JUSTICE (2015 ACT) (COMMENCEMENT NO. 4) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2015 (SR 2015 NO. 418 (C. 36)

The Department of Justice has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Justice (2015 Act) (Commencement No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015" (SR 2015 No. 418 (C. 36)), which was made on 17 December 2015.

The Rule brings certain sections of the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2015 (c.9 (N.I)) into operation.

Sections 94 and 96 are brought into operation on 29th January 2016. Section 94 introduces a power for a court, in criminal proceedings, to order access to specified premises for the defendant where it is required to ensure compliance with Article 6 of the European Convention on Human Rights.

Section 96 amends Section 5 of the Domestic Violence, Crime and Victims Act 2004 (offence of causing or allowing the death of a child or vulnerable adult) to also make it an offence to cause or allow a child or vulnerable adult to suffer serious physical harm.

Finally, section 41 and Schedule 4 are brought into operation on 1st March 2016 to make provision for a review mechanism as part of the filtering scheme operated by AccessNI to enable a person to seek, in certain circumstances, an independent review of their case where a conviction or other disposal has not been filtered from their standard or enhanced criminal record certificate.

The provision includes an automatic referral for cases where disclosures relate only to spent convictions or other disposals which occurred at a time when a person was under the age of 18.
