Community involvement is an important part of the process of preparing the new Local Development Plan for Belfast. Section 4 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 places a statutory duty on Councils to prepare a Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) which sets out how and when stakeholders and other interested parties will be consulted and involved in the preparation of the Local Development Plan (LDP), as well as in Development Management.
