The comprehensive Double Taxation Convention between the UK and Turkmenistan, which was signed on 10 June 2016 in Ashgabat, entered into force on 19 December 2016. The text of the Double Taxation Convention has been published as the Schedule to the Double Taxation Relief and International Tax Enforcement (Turkmenistan) Order 2016 (Statutory Instrument 2016 No. 1217), copies of which can be obtained from The Stationery Office. The provisions of the Double Taxation Convention will take effect a) in Turkmenistan: (i) with respect to taxes withheld at source, for amounts of income payable on or after 1st January 2017; (ii) with respect to other taxes charged on income of taxable periods beginning on or after 1st January 2017; b) in the United Kingdom: (i) with respect to taxes withheld at source, for amounts of income payable on or after 1st January 2017; (ii) with respect to income tax and capital gains tax, for any year of assessment beginning on or after 6th April 2017; (iii) with respect to corporation tax, for any financial year beginning on or after 1st April 2017. Notwithstanding the above, the provisions of Article 23 (Mutual agreement procedure) and Article 24 (Exchange of information) shall have effect from 19 December 2016, without regard to the taxable period to which the matter relates. The 1974 USSR/UK Agreement for the Avoidance of Double Taxation of Air Transport Undertakings and their Employees and the 1985 USSR/UK Convention for the Avoidance of Double Taxation with respect to Taxes on Income and Capital Gains (the 1985 Convention) shall cease to have effect in respect of any tax with effect from the date upon which this Convention has effect in respect of that tax. By submitting Notices to The Gazette after the Publisher has published notice of such modifications, the Advertiser, including any principal, agrees to be bound by the revised Terms and Conditions.

#### 1 Definitions

1.3 any reference to any legislative provision shall be deemed to include any subsequent re-enactment or amending provision.

2 By submitting a Notice to the Publisher, the Advertiser agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions which, unless stated otherwise in these Terms and Conditions, represent the entire terms agreed between the parties in relation to the publication of Notices in The Gazette and which every Notice shall be subject to. For the avoidance of doubt, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail over any other terms or conditions (whether or not inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions) contained or referred to in any correspondence or documentation submitted by the Advertiser or implied by custom, practice or course of dealing which the parties agree shall not apply, unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing by the Publisher.

3 The Publisher reserves the right, to be exercised at its sole and absolute discretion, to make reasonable efforts to verify the validity of the Advertiser.

4 The Publisher may, at its sole and absolute discretion, edit the Notice, subject to the following restrictions:

4.2 Notices shall be edited for house style only, not for content;

4.3 Notices can be edited to remove obvious duplications of information;

4.4 Notices can be edited to re-position material for style;

4.5 any additions, amendments or deletions required in order to include the minimum necessary information set out in any Notice guidelines shall be confirmed with the Advertiser; and

4.6 subject to clause 5 below, no amendments to the text (other than those made as a consequence of 4.1 - 4.5 above) shall be made without confirmation from the Advertiser.

7 For the avoidance of doubt, subject to clause 6 above, in no circumstances shall the Publisher be liable for any economic losses (including, without limitation, loss of revenues, profits, contracts, business or anticipated savings), any loss of goodwill or reputation, or any special, indirect or consequential damages (however arising, including negligence).

8 Where the Publisher is responsible for any error including which, in the Publisher's reasonable opinion, causes a substantive change to the meaning of a Notice or would affect the legal efficacy of a Notice, upon becoming aware of such error, the Publisher shall publish the corrected Notice at no charge and at the next suitable opportunity. Both parties agree (including on behalf of any principal, if applicable) that this shall be the sole remedy of the Advertiser (including any principal, if applicable) and full extent of the limit of the Publishers liability in these circumstances.

11.1 that it has the right, power and authority to submit the Notice; 11.2 the Notice is not false, inaccurate, misleading, nor does it contain potentially fraudulent information;

11.3 the Notice is submitted in good faith, does not contravene any law (statutory or otherwise) nor is it in any way illegal, defamatory or an infringement of any other party's rights or an infringement of the

British Code of Advertising Practice (as amended and updated from time to time), nor is it subject to any court order prohibiting such publication.

12 To the extent permissible by law the Publisher excludes all warranties, conditions or other terms, whether implied by statute or otherwise, relating to the placing of any Notices.

13 The Advertiser agrees to fully indemnify and hold the Publisher and The National Archives (or any successor organisation), including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice, including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach, threatened and/or potential breach by the Advertiser (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or any breach and/or potential breach by the Advertiser of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party. The Publisher may require the Advertiser to amend the Notice at its own cost before it agrees to republish the Notice if it is capable of rectification to avoid the claim, threatened or suspected claim. Any reinstatement of the Notice shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Publisher, whose decision in respect of such matter shall be final. 15 The Advertiser acknowledges that the Publisher may re-use Notices and/or allow third parties to re-use Notices accepted for publication in The Gazette, and hereby assigns to the Publisher for and on behalf of the Crown, all rights, including but not limited to, copyright and/or other such intellectual property rights (as applicable) in all Notices, and warrants that any such activity in respect of any Notice (including any activity in the preparation of such Notice for publication in The Gazette) by the Publisher and/or third parties does not and will not infringe any legal right of the Advertiser or any third party. For the avoidance of doubt, all Notices and any content therein shall be Crown copyright and may be subject to the Open Government Licence (or any variation thereof).

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18.1 The Local Newspaper Notice may be placed in a local newspaper by any subcontractor and/or a third party organisation at the Publisher's sole and absolute discretion and the Advertiser hereby consents to such use (including any activity that is ancillary and/or reasonably necessary to such use). For the avoidance of doubt, this may include the processing of personal data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998, as amended ("DPA"), by the Publisher, any subcontractor and/or third party organisation, together with the local newspaper and related organisations:

18.2 The placement of a Local Newspaper Notice shall be upon the standard terms and conditions of the local newspaper in question in addition to these Terms and Conditions. The Advertiser expressly agrees to such local newspaper terms and by submitting a Local Newspaper Notice to The Gazette, expressly consents to the Publisher, its subcontractors and/or any applicable third party organisation agreeing to such terms on behalf of the Advertiser;

19 In the event that a corrected Local Newspaper Notice is not published for whatever reason, the total aggregate liability of the Publisher and The National Archives, whether direct or indirect, and including (without limitation) all liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, costs (including all interest, penalties, legal costs and/or other professional costs and/or expenses) suffered or incurred, howsoever arising (including negligence), whether arising from the acts and/or omissions of the Publisher, The National Archives and/or the Advertiser and/or any third party (including, without limitation, any principal of the Advertiser) or arising out of or made in connection with the Notice or otherwise shall be limited to the value of the Local Newspaper Notice placed through The Gazette except that nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall limit or exclude any liability for fraudulent misrepresentation, or for death or personal injury resulting from the Publisher's or The National Archives' negligence or the negligence of the their agents, subcontractors and/or employees or third parties acting on behalf of the Publisher.

20 The Advertiser accepts that the Charges may be amended from time to time and will be payable at the rate in force at the time of invoicing unless otherwise agreed by the Publisher in writing.
