THE SOCIAL SECURITY (INFECTED BLOOD AND THALIDOMIDE) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2017

These Regulations provide that payments made:

- under or by certain schemes or trusts established for the purpose of providing compensation to those who have been infected from contaminated blood products,
- under the Infected Blood Payment Scheme for Northern Ireland;
- under the Scottish Infected Blood Support Scheme, or
- under or by certain trusts established for the purpose of giving relief

and assistance to disabled people whose disabilities were caused by the fact that during their pregnancy their mother had taken the drug known as Thalidomide, are to be ignored for certain social security purposes.

Regulations 4 and 9 amend the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) Regulations 1997 (S.R. 1997 No. 1183) and the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) (Lump Sum Payments) Regulations 2008 (S.R. 2008 No. 355) to exempt such payments from the compensation recovery schemes established under the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

Regulations 2, 3 and 5 to 8 amend the following Regulations to provide that payments made by such schemes are not taken into account in the calculation of income or capital:

- the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 (S.R. 1987 No. 459),
- the Jobseeker's Allowance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996 (S.R. 1996 No. 198),
- the State Pension Credit Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 (S.R. 2003 No. 28),
- the Housing Benefit Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006 (S.R. 2006 No. 405),
- the Housing Benefit (Persons who have attained the qualifying age for state pension credit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006 (S.R. 2006 No. 406), and
- the Employment and Support Allowance Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2008 (S.R. 2008 No. 280).

Regulations 6 and 7 also provide that evidence may be required from claimants in respect of payments from the Scottish Infected Blood Support Scheme in accordance with the evidence and information provisions of the Housing Benefit Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006 and the Housing Benefit (Persons who have attained the qualifying age for state pension credit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

1. an Order under Part VII of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (the "**Act**") sanctioning a scheme (the "**Scheme**") providing for the transfer to Rombalds Run-off Limited ("**Rombalds**") of the entire business of the UK branch of Nisshin; and
2. an Order making ancillary provision in connection with the implementation of the Scheme under Section 112 of the Act.

The business to be transferred comprises the inwards reinsurance contracts written by or on behalf of Nisshin through its inwards reinsurance handling departments (which in various different periods have included the Fire Underwriting Department, the Casualty Underwriting Department, the Marine Department, the Fire & Casualty Department, the Reinsurance Department, the International Department, the Reinsurance & International Department and the Underwriting Department of Nisshin) before 1 January 2014, and now administered in the UK.

The proposed transfer will result in all of the inwards reinsurance business carried on by Nisshin in the UK being carried on by Rombalds. The proposed transfer will secure the continuation by or against Rombalds of any legal proceedings by or against Nisshin that relate to rights and obligations in respect of the transferred business. All claims being dealt with before the transfer on behalf of Nisshin will following the transfer be dealt with on behalf of Rombalds; all claims arising after the transfer will be dealt with on behalf of Rombalds.
