THE PENSION SCHEMES ACT 2015 (JUDICIAL PENSIONS) (CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISION) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2018

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Pension Schemes Act 2015 (Judicial Pensions) (Consequential Provision) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2018" (S.R. 2018 No. 28), which comes into operation on 19 February 2018.

The Rule revokes and re-enacts the Pension Schemes Act 2015 (Judicial Pensions) (Consequential Provision No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017 which would otherwise cease to have effect by virtue of section 85(3)(b) of the Pension Schemes Act 2015. The Rule makes a technical amendment to section 31 of the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014 ("the 2014 Act") in consequence of section 78 of the Pension Schemes Act 2015 which inserted section 18A of the Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993 ("the 1993 Act"). This is to ensure that the relationship between the 2014 Act and a scheme for fee-paid judges established by section 18A of the 1993 Act is the same as the relationship between the 2014 Act and other judicial pension schemes established under the 1993 Act.

18.2 The placement of a Local Newspaper Notice shall be upon the standard terms and conditions of the local newspaper in question in addition to these Terms and Conditions. The Advertiser expressly agrees to such local newspaper terms and by submitting a Local Newspaper Notice to The Gazette, expressly consents to the Publisher, its subcontractors and/or any applicable third party organisation agreeing to such terms on behalf of the Advertiser;
