REVISED STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

Section 4 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 places a statutory duty on Councils to prepare a Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) which sets out how and when stakeholders and other interested parties will be consulted and involved in the preparation of the Local Development Plan (LDP), as well in Development Management.

The SCI was adopted by Belfast City Council on 4 April 2016 and approved by the Department for Infrastructure on 11 May 2016. This has since been revised.

The revised SCI was agreed by Council on 4 December 2017 and approved by the Department for Infrastructure on 29 March 2018. In accordance with Regulation 7 of the Planning (Statement of Community Involvement) Regulations (NI) 2015, Belfast City Council hereby gives notice of that decision.
