Regulation 11 of the Common Agricultural Policy Basic Payment and Support Schemes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015 (Active Farmers) relates to businesses which operate airports, railway services, waterworks, real estate services, permanent sport and recreational grounds, known as the 'negative list'. These businesses were prohibited from receiving Basic Payment Scheme payments unless they met certain conditions. The negative list provisions have been discontinued in Northern Ireland from the 2018 scheme year. This Statutory Rule revokes Regulation 11 with effect from the 2018 scheme year.
