THE PROTECTION OF FREEDOMS ACT 2012 (RELEVANT OFFICIAL RECORDS) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2018 MAKING/ OPERATION

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Justice has made the following Statutory Rule in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 101D(5), (6), (7) and (8) of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012.

PURPOSE

Chapter 5 of Part 5 of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 ("the 2012 Act") makes provision for a person who has a conviction or caution for a specific offence (in particular in relation to historical offences of buggery and gross indecency between men) to apply to the Department of Justice to have that conviction or caution disregarded. Section 101A of the 2012 Act sets out the circumstances in which such an application will be successful.

This Order, made under section 101D of the 2012 Act, prescribes which records of convictions and cautions, other than the main databases of police and criminal records, are relevant official records which will be deleted should an application for a disregard be successful. These have been identified as court records and any other locally held police records. When an application is successful, section 101D provides that the Department of Justice shall direct the relevant data controller of relevant official records to delete those records. Article 2 of this Order prescribes which official records, in addition to the names databases, are relevant official records for this purpose. Article 3 prescribes the relevant data controllers in relation to those official records and Article 4 makes provision, in accordance with section 101D of the 2012 Act, for certain records to be annotated rather than deleted.

This Order comes into operation on 28 June 2018.

THE POLICING AND CRIME ACT 2017 (COMMENCEMENT NO.2)
ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2018
MAKING/OPERATION**

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Justice has made the following Statutory Rule in exercise of the powers conferred by section 183(4) of the Policing and Crime Act 2017 ("the 2017 Act").

PURPOSE

Section 168 of the 2017 Act inserts sections 101A to 101J as Chapter 5 of Part 5 of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012. These sections make provision for a person who has a conviction or caution for a specific offence (in particular in relation to historical offences of buggery and gross indecency between men) to apply to the Department of Justice to have that conviction or caution disregarded and set out the circumstances in which such an application will be successful.

Section 169 of the 2017 Act makes provision for an automatic posthumous pardon for a person who has a conviction or caution for an offence as specified in section 169(2) and who has died before this section came into force.

Section 170 of the 2017 Act provides that where a person, who is living at the time this section comes into force, has a conviction or caution that becomes disregarded under Chapter 5 of Part 5 of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012, the person is also pardoned for the offence at that time.

Section 172 of the 2017 Act makes supplementary provisions in relation to pardons, regulations made under section 171 and the prerogative of mercy.

This Order comes into operation on 28 June 2018.

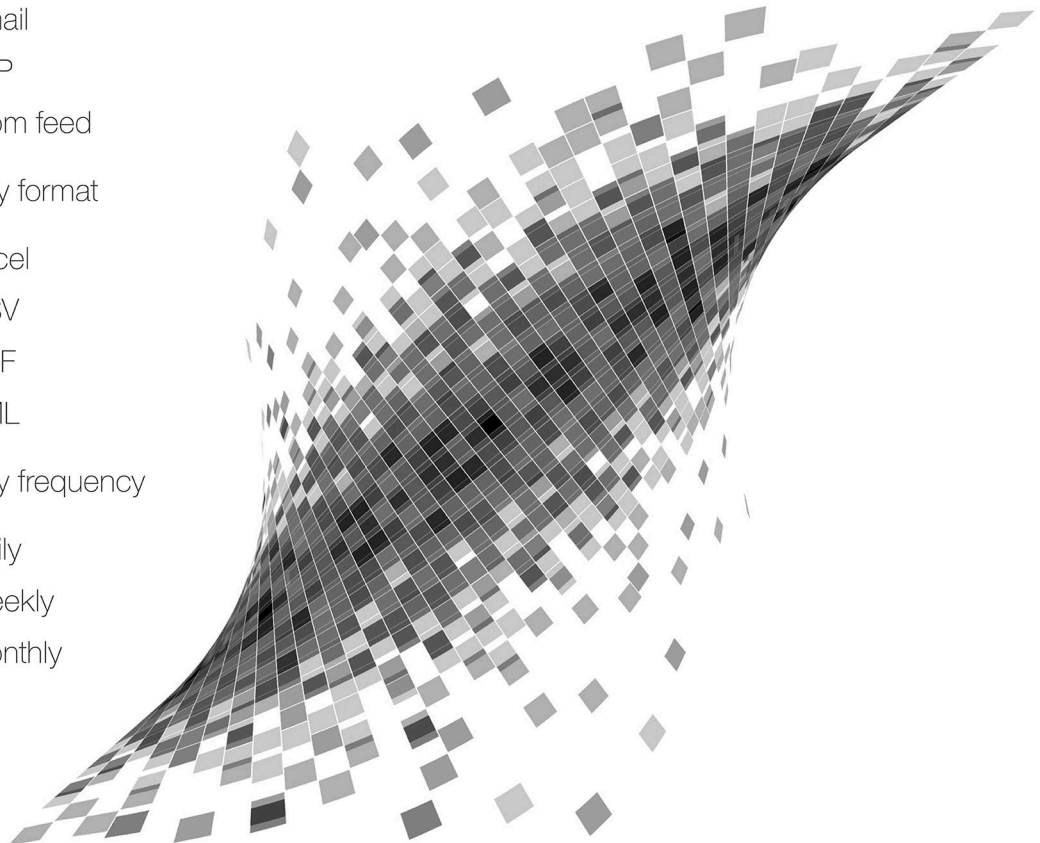
