#### THE GAS (DESIGNATION OF PIPELINES) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2019 GAS

The Department has made a Statutory Rule entitled the "Gas (Designation of Pipelines) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019" which will come into operation on 4th February 2019.

This Statutory Rule designates the high pressure sections of new gas pipelines constructed as part of the 'Gas to the West' project for the purposes of ensuring that prices charged in gas bills for the conveyance of gas through such pipelines are in accordance with the common transmission tariff under Article 59 of the Energy (NI) Order 2003.

The new high pressure gas pipelines designated in the "Gas (Designation of Pipelines) Order (NI) 2019" run from Portadown to Dungannon, and from Dungannon to Tullykenney near Fivemiletown, and are due to become operational in 2019.

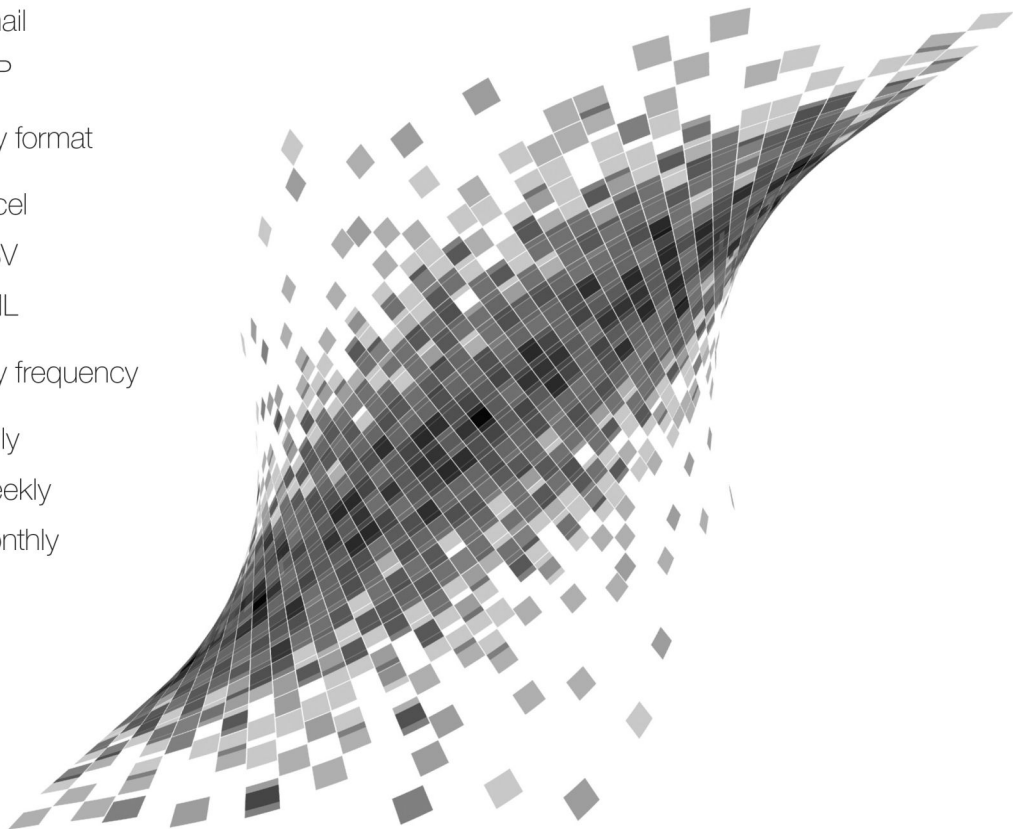

23 These Terms and Conditions and all other express terms of the contract shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of England and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
