MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

DETERMINATION OF THE JOINT MILK COUNCIL FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

The Joint Milk Council for Northern Ireland, in exercise of its powers under Section Six of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, hereby determines as follows:—

AMENDMENT OF THE DETERMINATION OF THIRTIETH JULY, 1936.

The Determination of the Joint Milk Council of the 30th July, 1936, shall, during the period 24th January, 1937, to the 8th May, 1937, have effect as follows:

- (1) as if paragraph (1) of Part I (Producers' Prices) was deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

"Milk of Grade A, Grade B and Grade C shall be sold by the holder of a Producer's licence to the holder of a Distributor's licence at the following prices for quantities of not less than two gallons per day delivered at the purchaser's premises:—

- (a) For milk sold loose in level daily deliveries:
Milk of Grade A—Not less than 1/4d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade B—1/2d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade C—1/2d. per gallon.

- (b) For milk sold loose in varying daily deliveries:

Milk of Grade A—Not less than 1/7d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade B—1/5d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade C—1/5d. per gallon.

- (c) For milk bottled by the producer—Not less than 1/1½d. per gallon above the price for the appropriate grade and type of delivery of milk sold loose, bottles and caps being supplied by the purchaser."

- (2) as if after the word "inclusive" in Part III (Retail Prices) paragraph (1) (a) the words:

"Milk of Grade A—Not less than 2/- per gallon.
Milk of Grade B—1/10d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade C—1/8d. per gallon."

were deleted and the following words substituted therefor:

"Milk of Grade A—Not less than 2/2d. per gallon.
Milk of Grade B—2/- per gallon.
Milk of Grade C—1/10d. per gallon.

Provided that notwithstanding any other provision in this Determination milk sold by retail and collected by the purchaser from the vendor's premises may be sold at not more than 6d. per gallon less than the appropriate retail price and that
