THE DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE NOTICE OF PROPOSED DRAINAGE SCHEME NOT LIKELY TO HAVE SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT GREENAN ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT SCHEME, WARRENPOINT ROAD AREA, NEWRY, CO. DOWN

The Department for Infrastructure hereby gives notice, in pursuance of Article 12A (3) of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (as amended) that it proposes to carry out a drainage scheme on the Greenan Road Stream, which traverses the Greenan Rd, Newry.

There is significant flood risk associated with the existing watercourse infrastructure. The Drainage Scheme is required to improve the standard of protection and alleviate the risk of flooding. In addition, the scheme will upgrade the existing watercourse infrastructure to an acceptable standard and facilitate future inspection and maintenance by Dfl Rivers personnel.

The proposed works will involve the upgrade along the existing line with approximately 75m of new 900mm diameter concrete pipe and structural re-lining of 85m of 750mm diameter pipe. A new inlet grille structure will also be constructed as part of the works.

Having taken account of the characteristics of the works in the proposed scheme, their location and potential impacts, the Department considers the proposed scheme is not likely to have significant environmental effects and does not intend to prepare an Environmental Statement.
