

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT,
1936.

NOTICE is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Department of Health for Scotland, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, to make regulations, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Additional Benefits) Amendment Regulations, 1937;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Department of Health for Scotland, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made Regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Additional Benefits) Amendment Regulations, 1937, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations, and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.
