#### ADMINISTRATIVE COUNTY OF DOWN.

To the Council of the Administrative County of Down; to the Council of the Rural District of Banbridge; and to all whom it may concern:

WHEREAS under sub-section (2) of section 27 of the Local Government (Ireland) Act, 1898, and the Certificate of the Local Government Board for Ireland, bearing date the Sixteenth day of June, 1902, made thereunder, the limit of annual expenditure on roads in the Rural District of Banbridge which may be approved of without the consent of the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, by the Council of the Administrative County of Down (hereinafter referred to as the County Council), is £10,111 7s 7d.

And whereas the said Ministry is satisfied that the expenditure on the roads of the said Rural District for the local financial year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, 1924, of the said sum of £10,111 7s 7d will not admit of the said roads being kept in proper condition and repair:
