These Regulations extend the emergency notice to quit period to 4 May 2022. These Regulations protect tenants from eviction for a reasonable and specified period of time and provide that landlords must give their tenants at least 12 weeks' notice to quit a dwelling house let under a private tenancy.

The Rule forms part of a package of regulations alongside the Occupational Pension Schemes (Climate Change Governance and Reporting) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021 which impose requirements on trustees of certain occupational pension schemes with a view to ensuring that there is effective governance of those schemes with respect to the effects of climate change and which also impose related reporting and publication requirements. It introduces requirements about trustee knowledge and understanding of matters relating to the effects of climate change on occupational pension schemes, for trustees who are subject to the climate change governance and reporting requirements. The Rule also makes consequential amendments to existing regulations in relation to disclosure and notification requirements.

The Rule introduces requirements for trustees of certain occupational pension schemes to ensure that there is effective governance of those schemes with respect to the effects of climate change. It also introduces related reporting and publication requirements for such trustees and confers new compliance powers on the Pensions Regulator. The requirements will apply to trustees on a phased basis from 1st October 2021 according to the value of relevant scheme assets, or whether the scheme has been authorised for certain purposes.

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Pensions Regulator (Information Gathering Powers and Modification) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021" (S.R. 2021 No. 243), which comes into operation on 1st October 2021.

The Rule sets out the minimum information which the Pensions Regulator must include in a notice which requires a person to attend an interview under extended provisions introduced by the Pension Schemes Act 2021. It also modifies the Regulator's extended inspection powers so they apply to multi-employer schemes and sets the level of the fixed and escalating civil penalties.

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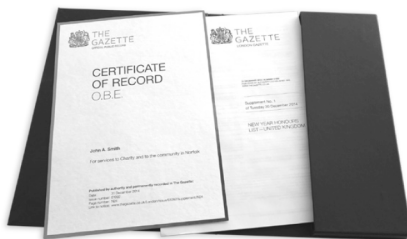
