DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE STOPPING-UP – KINGS LANE, WARRENPOINT

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI), gives notice of its proposal to stop-up Kings Lane, Warrenpoint to vehicular traffic at a line commencing 62 metres north-east of its junction with Church Street and at a line commencing 3.5 metres north-east of its junction with Church Street. ONE WAY TRAFFIC – BALLYNURE

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The One-Way Traffic (Ballynure) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021" (S.R. 2021 No. 279), which comes into operation on 28 October 2021.

The Rule will introduce a one-way traffic system on a length of Main Street, Ballynure, so that traffic can only proceed in a clockwise direction from a point 8 metres south-west of its junction with Gullivers Lane to its junction with Belfast Road.

The Department for Infrastructure on 6th September 2021 approved under Article 23 of the Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 and by the Road Traffic Offenders (Prescribed Devices) Order (Northern Ireland) 1997 (S.R. 1997 No. 280), the manually activated device designed or adapted for recording a measurement of the speed of motor vehicles by means of a light beam or beams as stated below.

The Approval approves from and including 6th September 2021, the device known as the LTI 20/20 TruCAM II speed enforcement device manufactured by Laser Technology Inc. of Colorado USA. (3898133)

The Order will prohibit vehicles proceeding in a south-westerly direction along Bridge Street, Belfast from making a U-Turn at its junction with High Street. The Order also revokes and re-enacts provisions in relation to the prohibition of U-Turns at other locations in Belfast.

PARKING PLACES ON ROADS & WAITING RESTRICTIONS – DUNGANNON

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021" (S.R. 2021 No. 280), which comes into operation on 28 October 2021.

The Rule will revoke certain existing parking places and waiting restrictions on lengths of Castle Hill, Scotch Street and Thomas Street. The Order will replace them with –

- parking places on lengths of Castle Hill, Scotch Street and Thomas Street, with parking limited to 1 hour with return to a parking place prohibited for 1 hour between 8.15 a.m. and 6.15 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive;
- parking places for the use of disabled persons' vehicles only, with unlimited waiting, on lengths of Castle Hill in front of No. 2 and to the side of Ranfurly House Arts and Visitor Centre and Scotch Street in front of No. 14/16;
- a no waiting at any time restriction (loading and unloading permitted) on a length of Market Square; and
- a no waiting at any time restriction (loading and unloading not permitted) on a length of Market Square.

The Rule will also introduce a no waiting at any time restriction (loading and unloading not permitted) on a length of Moy Road and Tamnamore Close and amend the description of an existing loading bay in Market Square.

Vehicles are excepted from the restrictions in certain circumstances.

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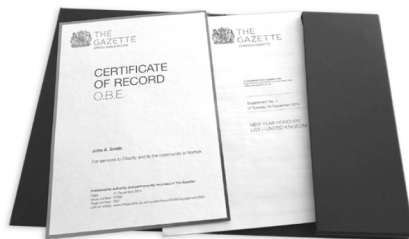

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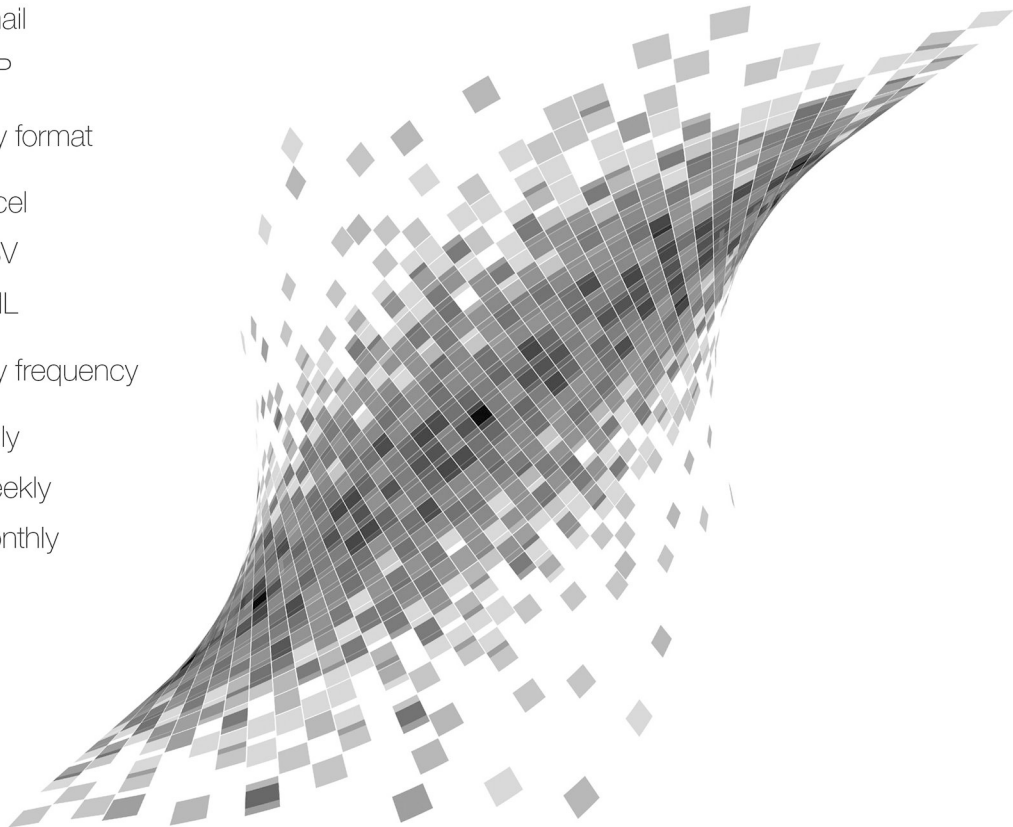
