The following Letter Patent was signed by His Majesty The King on 23rd March 2023 in respect of the Budget (Scotland) (No. 2) Bill ASP 2.

CHARLES THE THIRD by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories King Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament

GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.

WITNESS Ourselves at Buckingham Palace on the 23rd day of March in the first year of Our Reign.

THE OCCUPATIONAL PENSION SCHEMES (GOVERNANCE AND REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2023

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Occupational Pension Schemes (Governance and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023" (S.R. 2023 No. 52), which comes into operation on 30th March 2023.

The Rule revokes and re-enacts the Occupational Pension Schemes (Governance and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022 which would otherwise cease to have effect by virtue of section 51(3)(b) of the Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2015. It integrates, into pensions law, provisions of the Investment Consultancy and Fiduciary Management Markets Investigation Order 2019 made by the Competition and Markets Authority. It also enables the Pensions Regulator to oversee compliance by trustees of relevant pension schemes to allow for effective monitoring and enforcement.

The Department of Finance has made an Order entitled 'The Public Service Pensions Revaluation Order (Northern Ireland) 2023', (S.R.2023 No.54), which comes into operation on 1st April 2023 or from 6 April 2023 for those schemes who have amended their revaluation process accordingly for 2023.

The Order fulfils the Department of Finance's obligation under Section 9 of the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014 to make a pension related revaluation Order each year. The Order is used by public service pension schemes to uprate benefits accrued by active scheme members in each scheme year, with reference to the procedure set out in the scheme rules.
