THE KILLINCHY ROAD, COMBER (ABANDONMENT) ORDER (NI) 2023

ABANDONMENT – KILLINCHY ROAD, COMBER

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled “The Killinchy Road, Comber (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2023” (S.R. 2023 No.153) which comes into operation on 9th November 2023.

The effect of the rule is to abandon an area of 1090 square metres of superseded road at Killinchy Road, Comber, extending from a point 29 metres east of its junction with Drumhirk Road, for a distance of 319 metres in a southerly direction.

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME – LARNE

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled “The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Larne) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2023”, (S.R. 2023 No.152), which comes into operation on 19th October 2023.

The Order will prohibit vehicles waiting at any time (loading and unloading not permitted) on lengths of Kent Avenue, Larne. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

13 The Notice Placer agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and
