This rule will authorise lengths of Bishop Street Within, Londonderry for use as parking places and prescribe under what conditions they may be used and further will prohibit vehicles waiting at any time on lengths of Abbey Street (loading and unloading not permitted), Bishop Street Within and Bonds Hill (loading and unloading permitted), Londonderry. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances. The legislation will also consolidate existing parking and waiting restrictions in Londonderry into one Statutory Rule.

### PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2014 THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PENSION SCHEME (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NI) 2023

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Local Government Pension Scheme (Amendment No.2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023", (S.R. 2023 No. 149), which comes into operation on 1 October 2023.

These Regulations amend the Local Government Pension Scheme (Northern Ireland) (LGPS (NI)) to remove unlawful discrimination found in transitional protection arrangements in public service pension schemes by the McCloud judgment. In the LGPS (NI), transitional protection is provided by a statutory underpin. The underpin compares each member's career average pension against their final salary pension, and awards them an addition, if the final salary pension would have been higher over the remedy period. These Regulations implement the McCloud remedy in the LGPS (NI) by extending the underpin to younger members.

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Occupational Pension Schemes (Administration, Investment, Charges and Governance) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023" (S.R. 2023 No. 158), which comes into operation on 1st October 2023.

The Rule revokes and re-enacts the Occupational Pension Schemes (Administration, Investment, Charges and Governance) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023 which would otherwise cease to have effect by virtue of section 51(3)(b) of the Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2015. It amends existing Regulations to require trustees or managers of most defined contribution occupational pension schemes to publish their policies on investment in illiquid assets (assets that cannot easily or quickly be sold or exchanged for cash) and information about the types of assets in which the scheme has investments. It also provides that specified performance-based fees will fall outside of the regulatory charge cap calculation.
