The Protection from Stalking Act (Northern Ireland) 2022 ("the Act") received Royal Assent on 26 April 2022. S.R. 2023 No. 174 brings sections 6 to 17 of "the Act" - which allow for the creation of Stalking Protection Orders (SPOs) - into operation on 19th October 2023. SPOs provide immediate protection to a person at risk of stalking. They enable early police intervention pre-conviction to address and potentially disrupt stalking behaviours, before they become entrenched or escalate in severity, and to protect victims from more serious harm. S.R. 2023 No. 175 makes technical changes to magistrates' court rules to allow police to apply to the magistrates' court for an SPO if it appears that a person has carried out acts associated with stalking; poses a risk associated with stalking to another person; and there is reasonable cause to believe the SPO is necessary to protect another person from such risk. Police will apply for the orders, taking the onus away from the victim, and orders will also be available for respondents under the age of 18 (applications for which will be heard in a youth court).
