

Authorities (Special Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922, and it is provided by sub-section (3) of Section 1 of the said Act that the Minister of Home Affairs shall have power to make Regulations : (a) for making further provisions for the preservation of the Peace and Maintenance of Order, and (b) for varying or revoking any previous Regulations, whether contained in the said Schedule, or made as aforesaid, and that any Regulations made as aforesaid shall, subject to the provisions of the said Act, have effect and be enforced in like manner as Regulations contained in the said Schedule :

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Bart., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, by this Regulation do make further provision for the preservation of Peace and Maintenance of Order, and do hereby as from the date hereof revoke paragraphs 7 and 8 of Regulation 22 (b) contained in the said Schedule and order that the following paragraph shall be substituted therefor.

7. If any person brought before a Resident Magistrate under this Regulation refuses to be sworn or refuses to answer a question put to him at an examination held under this Regulation, or refuses to recognise the authority of the Resident Magistrate to hold such examination or to put such questions; or states that he is a member of an Association declared by these Regulations to be an unlawful Association, he shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations and the Resident Magistrate who conducts the examination shall so certify under his hand and such certificate shall be evidence of the facts therein stated in any prosecution under these Regulations.

EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

Whereas Sergeant Thomas A. Stafford (No. 1256) of the Royal Ulster Constabulary was, on the 2nd day of November, 1928, appointed to be an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the Explosives Act, 1875 :

And whereas the said Sergeant Thomas A. Stafford is no longer available for the duties of Inspector :

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home

Affairs for Northern Ireland, in virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the said Act, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do hereby order that the said Sergeant Thomas A. Stafford shall from this date cease to exercise the powers and perform the duties of an Inspector under the said Act.

EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

MARKETING OF EGGS.

DETERMINATION OF WHOLESALE
DEALERS' PRICES.

ORDER DATED THE SEVENTH DAY OF JANUARY, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936.

The Ministry of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section one of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and in accordance with advice given by the Egg Marketing Committee for Northern Ireland hereby determines as follows, that is to say:—

1. The prices payable by licensed wholesale dealers for eggs delivered during the week ending Saturday, 8th January, 1938, shall be as follows:—

HEN EGGS.

- (a) (i) For hen eggs purchased by a licensed wholesale dealer from a producer where the eggs were pro-
