THE SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT (LETTERS PATENT AND PROCLAMATIONS) ORDER 1999

The following Letter Patent was signed by His Majesty The King on 25 January 2024 in respect of the Trusts and Succession (Scotland) Bill ASP 2.

CHARLES THE THIRD by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories King Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled “The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024” (S.R. 2024 No. 10) which comes into operation on 19th February 2024.

The Rule will apply a 40 miles per hour speed limits to a length of Clanabogan Road, Edenderry Road, Glenpark Road and Gortin Road, Newtownsaville Road, and Springhill Road, Omagh, and revokes and re-enacts a speed limit (national speed limit) on a length of Botera Upper Road, Omagh, which corrects a drafting error in S.R. 1998 No. 340. The Rule will apply a 20, 30, 40 and 50 miles per hour speed limits to lengths of road in Ballygawley, Dungannon and Newmills and de-restrict lengths of the A4 dual carriageway and associated link roads in Ballygawley.
