### THE MOTOR VEHICLES (DRIVING LICENCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2024

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2024" (S.R. 2024 No. 22), which comes into operation on 25th March 2024.

The purpose of the Regulations is to insert a new provision into the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996 which will extend the period for holders of a Ukrainian licence to drive on this licence in Northern Ireland from one year (12 months) after becoming resident in Northern Ireland, to three years (36 months). This increase matches the length of the visa they have been granted (Family, Sponsor and Extension visa schemes). This extension would only apply to the driving of a vehicle in Category A (motorcycle) and Category B (car). The Department of Health has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Adoption and Children (2022 Act)(Commencement No.2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024 (S.R. 30/2024 ). It will bring into operation, with effect from 1st April 2024, sections 116, 118, 120 and 143 of the Adoption and Children Act (Northern Ireland) 2022 which will amend the Children (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 (the Children Order) to: classify applications for Female Genital Mutilation Protection Orders as "family proceedings" for the purpose of the Children Order; extend the operation of Residence Orders for children looked after by a Health and Social Care Trust to age 18 unless deemed otherwise by a Court; require a Health and Social Care Trust to ascertain, and take into account, a child's wishes and feelings in relation to the provision of certain specified services, before determining what (if any) services to provide; and require a report on the operation of the Children Order to be completed every 3 years instead of annually. Section 158 will also come into operation with effect from 1st April 2024. This section places a duty on the Department to, at least every three years, prepare and publish a report on the implementation of each of the

provisions of Parts 1 and 2 of the Act and to lay a copy of the report before the Assembly. 6 Save for any liability that cannot be excluded or restricted by law, The National Archives or the Publisher's (including any successor organisations, affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and/or employees) total aggregate liability whether arising from the acts and/or omissions of The National Archives or the Publisher arising out of or made in connection with any Notice or otherwise for any and all liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, costs (including all interest, penalties, legal costs and other professional costs and/or expenses), whether in contract (including under an indemnity or warranty), tort (including negligence), misrepresentation, equity, breach of statutory duty, strict liability or otherwise incurred shall be limited to one hundred and fifty per cent (150%) of the value of the Charge paid for such Notice under these Terms and Conditions.

6A Other than as set out in clause 6 above, neither the Publisher, nor The National Archives, shall have any liability in respect of any act and/or omission of the Notice Placer and/or any third party or in respect of any Notice submitted by any Notice Placer for potential publication in The Gazette, which the Notice Placer warrants and accepts is solely its responsibility.

The Notice Placer agrees and accepts that the Publisher is reliant upon the services of the Royal Mail in order to deliver the Forwarding Service and accordingly any failure and/or inability of the Royal Mail to deliver the Forwarding Service shall in so far as reasonably possible not put the Publisher to be in breach of this Agreement unless the Publisher was the sole contributory to the breach and/or negligent on its part to properly supervise the Royal Mail in relation to the Services.

13 The Notice Placer agrees to fully indemnify (as a debt) and hold the Publisher and The National Archives or any successor organisation, including any affiliates, officers, directors, agents, subcontractors and employees harmless from all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including, without limitation) any direct, indirect, consequential and/or special losses and/or damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation and/or goodwill and all interest, penalties and legal costs (calculated on a full indemnity basis) and all other professional costs and/or expenses (including legal costs) suffered or incurred (including negligence) in respect of any matter arising out of, in connection with or relating to any Notice (including, without limitation, clause 11 of the Terms and Conditions) and

including (without limitation) in respect of any claim and/or demand (including threatened and/or potential claims or demands) made by any third party which may constitute a breach and/or potential breach by the Notice Placer (or their principal) of these Terms and Conditions or of any law and/or any of the rights of a third party. The Gazette will at all times act with confidentiality, discretion and adhere to any legislative requirements.
