The following Letter Patent was signed by His Majesty The King on 21 November 2024 in respect of the Climate Change (Emissions Reduction Targets) (Scotland) Bill. ASP 15.

CHARLES THE THIRD by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories King Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament

GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.

WITNESS Ourselves at Buckingham Palace the twenty-first day of November in the third year of Our Reign.

#### NOTICE OF TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS AND ENVIRONMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2011

Notice is hereby given that the Council in the exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 69A to 69E of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 as inserted in the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 proposes to make an order entitled the Belfast City Council Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Phase 5a.

A Rule is made each year to apply to those who attain their scheme’s normal pension age in the following calendar year. This year’s Rule affects people who reach the scheme’s normal pension age in 2025.

The Department for Communities has made a Statutory Rule entitled “The State Pension Debits and Credits (Revaluation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024” (S.R. 2024 No. 198), which came into operation in accordance with Article 1(1).

The Rule is made under the powers conferred by sections 130AD and 165(1) and (4) of the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992 and is subject to the negative resolution procedure. This Order specifies the percentage that will be used to revalue "protected payments" for individuals reaching state pension age on or after xth April 2025. A person has a protected payment if their "starting amount" – the part of their new state pension based on their pre-6 April 2016 contribution record – exceeded the full rate of new state pension as at 6 April 2016. The protected payment is the amount of the excess. Where the starting amount exceeds the full rate, paragraph 6(5) of Schedule 1 to the 2015 Act provides that the amount of the excess (i.e. the protected payment) is to be revalued by the percentage specified in the last Order made under section 130AC of the Administration Act to come into operation before the individual reaches state pension age.
