KING'S BENCH DIVISION—IN BANKRUPTCY

JOSEPH O'CONNOR, of 28 Ashton Street and 67 King Street, both in the County of the City of Belfast, Tobacconist and Newsagent, was on the 31st day of March, 1938, adjudged Bankrupt.
