#### PROHIBITION OF WAITING – SCHOOLS

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2025" (S.R. 2025 No. 160) which comes into operation on 22 October 2025.

The Rule will prohibit vehicles waiting Monday to Friday inclusive, 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m., between 31 August and 30 June on a length of Glenhead Road, Ballykelly at Ballykelly Primary School and Vale Road, Greysteel, Eglinton at Faughanvale Primary School. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibitions in certain circumstances.

##### STATUTORY RULE

#### THE ROADS (SPEED LIMIT) (NO.3) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2025 SPEED LIMITS

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2025" (S.R. 2025 No. 157) which comes into operation on 16th October 2025.

The Rule will–

- apply a 30 miles per hour speed limit to a length of Drumbo Road, Drumbo. This length of road is not a restricted road (street lighting has not been installed) and a 30mph restriction is necessary given the increase in the number of new developments accessed from this length of road.
- apply a 40 miles per hour speed limit to a length of McKinsty Road and Wilmar Road, Derriaghy. A reduction to the current speed limit will ensure it is consistent with other reductions in speed limits within the area and improve road safety.
- de-restrict a length of Gardiners Cross Road, Enniskillen so that the national speed limit applies. This length of road does not meet the criteria for a 30mph speed limit restriction even though street lighting was installed.
- revoke existing speed limits relating to Drumbo Road, McKinsty Road and Wilmar Road so that the speed limits specified above can take effect. Vehicles are excepted from the restrictions in certain circumstances.

#### THE CONTROL OF TRAFFIC (ISLAND STREET AREA BELFAST) (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2025

#### CONTROL OF TRAFFIC – ISLAND STREET AREA, BELFAST

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Control of Traffic (Island Street Area, Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2025", (S.R. 2025 No. 159), which comes into operation on 17th October 2025.

The Rule will –

- provide a segregated two-way cycle track on a length of Ballymacarrett Road and Island Street, Belfast;
- provide a shared footway/cycle track on a length of Dee Street and Island Street, Belfast;
- prohibit vehicles waiting at any time (loading and unloading permitted) on lengths of Ballymacarrett Road and Island Street, Belfast;
- prohibit vehicles waiting at any time (loading and unloading not permitted) on lengths of Ballymacarrett Road and Island Street, Belfast; and
- introduce parking places for disabled persons' vehicles with unlimited waiting on a length of Ballymacarrett Road, Belfast.

Vehicles are excepted from the prohibitions in certain circumstances.

## DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

### RECOVERY OF HEALTH SERVICES CHARGES (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 2006

The Department of Health has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Recovery of Health Services Charges (Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2025", (S.R. 2025 No. 158) which will come into operation on 1 October 2025.

This rule amends the principal Regulations to increase the charges in respect of injuries which occur on or after 1st October 2025. Where the injured person is provided with health care ambulance services, the charge is increased from £256 to £267 for each occasion. Where the injured person receives health care treatment but is not admitted to hospital the charge is increased from £848 to £883. The daily charge for health care in-patient treatment is increased from £1,042 to £1,085. The maximum charge in respect of an injury is increased from £62,272 to £64,856.
