### ROAD RESTRICTIONS

#### DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE ABANDONMENT AND STOPPING-UP – COMBER ROAD, DUNDONALD – RE-ADVERTISEMENT

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI), being of the opinion that the road is not necessary for road traffic, gives notice of its intention to make an Order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993, the effect of which would be, after completion of such works as the Department considers necessary to provide alternative facilities, to abandon an area of 608 square metres of former road at Comber Road, Dundonald comprising of two plots—

- 46 square metres adjacent to No. 1 Peartree Hill (Plot 1); and
- 562 square metres adjacent to No. 327 Comber Road, extending in a south-easterly direction towards the junction with Peartree Hill (Plot 2).

It will also stop-up to motor vehicles, four lengths of former road at Comber Road, Dundonald comprising—

- 26.8 metres outside No. 1 Peartree Hill;
- 6.8 metres extending in a south-westerly direction;
- 6.6 metres outside No. 327 Comber Road; and
- 46.5 metres extending in a south-easterly direction.

The areas of road proposed to be abandoned and the lengths to be stopped-up are delineated on a map which, together with a copy of a draft Order, may be inspected free of charge during office hours within the period 21 January 2026 to 2 March 2026 at DfI TRAM Eastern Division, Hydebank House, 4a Hospital Road, Ballydollahgan, Belfast, BT8 8JL or viewed online at [www.infrastructure-ni.gov.uk/consultations](http://www.infrastructure-ni.gov.uk/consultations)

### THE DOUBLE TAXATION RELIEF AND INTERNATIONAL TAX ENFORCEMENT (PERU) ORDER 2025 (SI. 2025 NO. 1299) UK/PERU DOUBLE TAXATION CONVENTION

The Double Taxation Convention between the UK and Peru, which was signed in London on 20th day of March 2025, entered into force on 21 January 2026. The text of the Double Taxation Convention has been published as the Schedule to the Double Taxation Relief and International Tax Enforcement (Peru) Order 2025 (Statutory Instrument 2025 No. 1299), copies of which can be obtained from The Stationery Office. The text of the Order can also be accessed on the Internet at [2025 No.1299](https://www.legislation.gov.uk/si/2025/1299).

The provisions of the Double Taxation Convention will take effect in the UK from 1 January 2027 for taxes withheld at source, 6 April 2026 for income tax and capital gains tax and 1 April 2026 for Corporation tax; in Peru from 1st January 2027 for taxes on income. (5040717)
