CIVIL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL POWERS) ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922 AND 1933.

Whereas by Regulation 26 of the Regulations contained in the Schedule to the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1922 and 1933, it is provided that the Civil Authority may by notice prohibit the circulation of any newspaper for any specified period, and that any person circulating or distributing such newspaper within such specified period shall be guilty of an offence against the Regulations in the said Schedule:

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Bart., D.L., M.P., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, being the Civil Authority under the said Act, do hereby in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 26 of the Regulations made under the authority of the above-mentioned Acts, prohibit the circulation of the following newspapers entitled:—

- "An Problacht" or "The Republic" or "The Loyalist" or "The Republican Press."
- "The Irish World and American Industrial Liberator."
- "Fianna."
- "Republican Congress."
- "An Siol" or "The Seed" and
- "Wolfe Tone Weekly Saiorse Na H'Eireann" or "Irish Freedom" or under any other title or alias whatever in

Northern Ireland from the 1st day of January, 1939, until the 31st day of December, 1939.
