Whereas by sub-section (1) of Section 30  
of the Unemployment Assistance Act  
(Northern Ireland), 1934, it is provided that  
there shall be constituted a Board to be  
called the Unemployment Assistance Board  
for Northern Ireland:

And whereas by the Fourth Schedule to  
the said Act it is further provided that the  
said Board shall consist of a chairman and  
not less than one nor more than four other  
members appointed by the Governor of  
Northern Ireland, and that every member  
of the Board shall hold and vacate office in  
accordance with the terms of his appoint-  
ment:

And whereas by Warrant dated the 15th  
day of July, 1937, Margaret Alicia Waring,  
C.B.E., J.P., widow of the late Major Holt  
Waring, D.L., J.P., was appointed, in pur-  
suance of the provisions of the aforesaid  
enactments, to be one of the members of  
the said Board until the 30th day of June,  
1939:
