Whereas by an Order of Her Majesty in Council, dated the seventeenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, Her Majesty was pleased, under or by virtue of the provisions of the Medical Acts, 1858 and 1886, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to nominate and appoint Sir Richard Quain, Baronet, M.D., F.R.S., to be a Member of the General Council of Medical Education and Registration of the United Kingdom.

And whereas under or by virtue of the provisions of the said Acts, the said Sir Richard Quain will cease to be a Member of the said General Council on the twenty-seventh day of November one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, doth under and by virtue of the provisions in that behalf contained in the Medical Acts, 1858 and 1886, nominate and appoint the said Sir Richard Quain to be again, for the term of five years from the twenty-seventh day of November instant, a Member of the said General Council of Medical Education and Registration of the United Kingdom.
