[^0]:    * Section 8 of the Corn Returus Act, 1882, provides that where returns of purchases of British Corn are made to the Local Inspector of Corn Returns in any other measure than the imperial bushel, or by weight or by a weighed measure, that Officer shall convert such retarns into the inperial bushel, and in the case of weight or weighed measure the conversion is to be made at the rate of sixty imperial ponnds for every bushel of wheat, fifty imperial pounds for every bushel of barley, and thirly-nine imperial pounds for every bushel of oats.
