Soya bean cake and meal; Sunflower seed cake and meal;

Chick peas, pigeon peas, gram or dhol: Dari;

Millet;

Molasses for cattle feeding;

Provisions and victuals which may be used as food for man, namely:—

Onions;

Potatoes;

Rye, rye flour and meal.

Now, therefore, their Lordships, having taken the said recommendation into consideration, are pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same be approved.

Whereof the Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs and Excise, the Director of the War Trade Department, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
