

ORDER APPLICABLE TO SCOTLAND, dated 9th February 1918, made by the Board of Agriculture for Scotland under Regulation 2R of the Defence of the Realm Regulations.

The Board of Agriculture for Scotland, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the above-mentioned Regulation, do hereby authorise the sale and the exposing for sale of blue or mountain hares and leverets in Scotland during the month of March nineteen hundred and eighteen, by any person who would be otherwise entitled to sell or expose the same for sale, and that notwithstanding anything contained in the Hares Preservation Act, 1892.

This Order may be cited as the Sale of Hares (Scotland) Order, 1918.
