TRADE BOARDS ACT, 1909.
SHIRT-MAKING TRADE BOARD.
(GREAT BRITAIN.)

In accordance with Regulations made under

Section 18 of the above Act by the Board of Trade, and dated 27th April 1910, the Trade Board established in Great Britain under the above Act for the Shirt-Making trade, as defined in the Regulations made by the Board of Trade and dated 26th December 1913, have given notice that they have varied certain minimum rates of wages fixed by them on 5th July 1915 and 12th February and 29th October 1917, the variations being as follows:—

- (a) For female workers other than Home-workers, from 4½d. an hour to 5d. an hour.
- (b) For female Home-workers, from 4½d. an hour to 5d. an hour.
- (c) For female learners:—
