

- be defined in the Order, and to use and appropriate and otherwise dispose of the materials thereby dredged or obtained.
7. To authorise the Town Council to take, use, and acquire, by agreement, land, houses, servitudes, rights, privileges, and other property which will or may be required for the purposes of the Order or for the general purposes of the Harbour or Harbour Undertaking, and to subsequently lease, sell, or otherwise deal with the same as they see fit.
  8. To empower the Town Council to provide, purchase, lease, hire, employ, and license, and to let on hire and sell dredgers, motor or other boats, engines, tugs, lighters, barges, or other vessels, diving bells, tools, plant, or other power materials and appliances for the use or accommodation of the Harbour and of the shipping and of traders and others frequenting the same, and to supply water to shipping in the Harbour.
  9. To authorise the Town Council to impose, assess, levy, and recover tolls, rates, rents, charges, and duties for or in respect of the use of the said Harbour and Harbour Undertaking or any part thereof and of any warehouses, buildings, sheds, yards, fish curing sheds or yards, fish mart, cold storage, weighing machines, dredgers, tugs, motor boats, and other vessels, buoys, works, conveniences, and relative appliances provided at or in connection with the same, and for water supplied and to provide for the application thereof to repeal or extinguish, amend, enlarge, alter, or vary the tolls, rates, rents, charges, and duties, or some of them, which are now levied or may in future be leviable by the Town Council in respect of the Harbour or Harbour Undertaking or any part thereof, to empower them to levy new or additional or to increase existing tolls, rates, rents, charges, and duties in respect thereof, and to confer, vary, or extinguish exemptions from the payment of such existing or new tolls, rates, rents, charges, and duties, and to compound for any such, and to make special provisions as to the reporting of and collection and recovery of rates on white fish and fresh herrings and other fish.
  10. To empower the Town Council to let or lease the Harbour Undertaking or any part thereof and the tolls, rates, duties and other charges authorised upon such terms and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.
  11. To empower the Town Council to let for hire or lease warehouses, sheds, buildings, and other lands and heritages separately from any other part of the undertaking, to set apart and appropriate berths and quay space, to appoint meters and weighers to manage, control, and regulate the Harbour and all vessels, traffic, and persons using the same, to make provision for the removal or detention of vessels within the Harbour or any part thereof, and for those and all other purposes connected with the Harbour and Harbour Undertaking to make, alter, and rescind rules, bye-laws, and regulations, and impose penalties and provide for the recovery and application of same.
  12. To authorise the Town Council to create and issue Annuities for such an amount and at such rates and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed, and to provide that the owners of the Redeemable Guaranteed Stock authorised by the Aberbrothwick Harbour Finance Act 1897 shall accept such Annuities in satisfaction of the principal and interest due to them, and deliver up their certificates upon such terms and under and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed, and for the cancellation of the Redeemable Guaranteed Stock and the issue, registration and transfer of such Annuities.
  13. To authorise the Town Council to pay a composition in cash or otherwise in satisfaction of the Redeemable Ordinary Stock authorised by the Aberbrothwick Harbour Finance Act 1897, and to provide that the holders of the Redeemable Ordinary Stock shall accept such composition in full satisfaction of the principal and interest due to them and for the cancellation of such Redeemable Ordinary Stock.
  14. To provide for the cancellation and extinguishment of such Redeemable Guaranteed Stock and Redeemable Ordinary Stock on notice, and to give power to persons under disability to accept Annuities and cash composition respectively for the same respectively.
  15. To constitute the Town Council, the Harbour and Pilotage Authority and Local Lighthouse Authority.
  16. To authorise the Town Council to borrow and re-borrow money, whether by credit at a bank or temporarily or otherwise for the purposes of the Order, on the security of the rates, tolls, dues, and assessments leviable by them, or which they may be authorised to levy under the Order, or otherwise, including the assessment hereinafter referred to and on the security of the Aberbrothwick or Arbroath Harbour and Undertaking and the lands and property connected therewith and the tolls, rates, dues, and duties arising therefrom, or upon the whole or any of the said securities, and to remove any legal disability affecting any body, Company, or person lending money to, or entering into contracts with the Town Council, and also to make all provisions necessary or expedient with reference to the repayment of monies borrowed or to be borrowed by the Town Council.
  17. To enable the Town Council to make, levy, charge, assess, and collect a Special Harbour Rate or Assessment on all owners and occupiers of lands or heritages within the Burgh for the purposes of the Order and of the Harbour and Harbour Undertaking and the lands and property connected therewith and the maintenance and management thereof, and the payment of the expenses in connection therewith, and for any payments in connection with the Harbour and Harbour Undertaking and other subjects, or any of them, such Special Harbour Rate or Assessment to be called the Arbroath Harbour Assess-
