(b) Male Workers employed as Cutters, Markers-out (other than Process Workers), Hand Pressers, Matchers-up and Shaders, who have had less than five years' experience but not less than three years' experience after the age of 19 years in Cutting, Marking-out (other than Process Working), Hand Pressing, Matching-up or Shading—General Minimum Time-Rates, from 1s. 5d. to 1s. 7d.; Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates, from 1s. 6½d. to 1s. $8\frac{1}{2}d$.

Provided that, for the purpose of reckoning previous experience, a Worker shall be entitled to count not more than 12 months' experience after the age of 19 years in Folding, Handor Shading-General Minimum Time- | Fitting, Parting, Separating or Making-up.
