## ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

## (DATED 16TH FEBRUARY 1921.)

## DISEASES OF ANIMALS (DUMFRIES-SHIRE) ORDER OF 1921.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows :---

# Power to make Regulations for Notification of the death of Cattle in certain cases.

1. The Local Authority of the District specified in the Schedule to this Order may, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, make Regulations—

(1) For prescribing and regulating the notice to be given to or by any person or authority in the case of illness of any head of cattle where the animal has died from the illness or been slaughtered on account thereof, and for supplementing or varying for those purposes any of the provisions of Section 4 of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894; and

(2) For regulating the removal or disposal of the carcase of any head of cattle to which any such notice relates, or of any dung, fodder or litter which has been in the same place with or used about any such head of cattle.

#### Limitation of Regulations.

2. (1) Nothing in any Regulations made Agricul under this Order shall require notice to be S.W. 1.

given in the case of death produced by, or consequent on, accident or calving.

(2) Nothing in any Regulations made under this Order shall affect the provisions of any Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries relating to cattle-plague, pleuro-pneumonia, foot-and-mouth disease, or anthrax.

## Confirmation of Regulations.

3. (1) Regulations made under this Order shall not take effect unless and until they have been submitted to and confirmed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.

(2) Unless the Ministry otherwise directs the following provisions shall apply:—

(i) Notice of intention to apply for confirmation of any Regulations shall be given in one or more of the local newspapers circulating within the District two weeks at least before the making of the application.

(ii) For two weeks at least before an application a copy of the Regulations proposed to be confirmed shall be kept at the office of the Local Authority of the District, and be open during office hours thereat to the inspection of ratepayers of the District without fee or reward.

(iii) The Clerk of the Local Authority shall on the application of any such ratepayer furnish him with a copy of the proposed Regulations on payment of sixpence.

(3) A copy of any Regulations made by the Local Authority under this Order, signed and certified by the Clerk of that Local Authority to be a true copy and to have been duly confirmed, shall be evidence, until the contrary is proved, in all legal proceedings, of the due making, confirmation, and existence of the Regulations, without further or other proof.

#### Offences.

4. Any person failing to give the notice prescribed by any Regulation made under this Order, or moving or disposing, or permitting the removal or disposal of, a carcase, or of any dung, fodder or litter, in contravention of any such Regulation, shall be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

#### Short Title.

5. This Order may be cited as the DISEASES OF ANIMALS (DUMFRIESSHIRE) ORDER OF 1921.
