The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows :—

*Application of Sheep (Double Dipping)
Order of 1920.*

1. Part I. (*Restriction on Movement of Sheep out of a Movement Area*), and Part II. (*Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area*) of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order," are hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be a Movement Area and a Double Dipping Area for the purposes of that Order.

Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.

2. The dates between which all sheep in the Area described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Area by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part II of the Principal Order are hereby fixed to be the third day of August and the seventh day of September.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-fourth day of June nineteen hundred and twenty-one.

Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.

The dates between which all sheep in the Area described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Area by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part II of the Principal Order are hereby fixed to be the seventeenth day of November and the thirtieth day of December.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of July nineteen hundred and twenty-one.
