of 48 hours *i.e.*, 8d. per hour. Provided also that this General Minimum Time-Rate shall be increased by 5s. per week of 48 hours, *i.e.*, 1¼d. per hour, in the case of any such worker who is 22 years of age or over. Workers to whom this proviso applies shall, on the expiration of 12 months' employment in the trade, receive such General Minimum Time-Rates as they may be entitled to under the provisions of this Schedule.

SECTION II.

Applicability of Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates.

In cases where a worker is employed on piece-work, each piece-rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, to an Ordinary worker an amount not less than the Piece-Work Basis Time-Rate applicable as set out in Section I. above. Provided that in determining as to whether any Piece-rate satisfies this condition, regard shall not be had to the earnings of workers under 22 years of age.

NOTE.—The employment of children under 14 years of age is subject to the provisions of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920.

PART II.

OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE WORKERS (ALL AGES).

SECTION I.

Normal Number of Hours of Work.

In accordance with Section (3) (1) (c) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board have declared the Normal Number of Hours of Work in the Trade to be as follows :—

In any Week	48
On any Day other than Saturday, Sunday and Customary Public and Statutory Holidays	9

Provided that all hours worked by a worker on Sunday and Customary Public and Statutory Holidays and hours worked on Saturday (subject to the provisions set out below) shall be regarded as Overtime, to which the Overtime Rates shall apply.

SECTION II.

Overtime Rates.

The Minimum Rates of Overtime in respect of all hours worked by a worker in excess of the declared normal number of hours shall be as follows :—

(A) For Male Workers employed on Time Work.

Overtime Rates for Ordinary Days (Time-workers).

(1) On any Day other than Saturday, Sunday and Customary Public and Statutory Holidays :—

- (a) For the first two hours of Overtime, One-and-a-Quarter times the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Time-and-a-Quarter.
- (b) For the second two hours of Overtime, One-and-a-Half times the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Time-and-a-Half.
- (c) For Overtime after the first four hours of Overtime, Twice the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Double-Time.

Where Attendance on Five Days a Week only is Required.

Provided that where it is or may become the established practice of an employer only to require attendance on five days a week, the Overtime Rates specified in paragraphs A (1) (a), (b) and (c) of this Section shall not be payable on any day (other than Saturday, Sunday, and Customary Public and Statutory Holidays) until the number of hours worked exceeds 9½, 11½ and 13½ respectively.

Overtime Rates for Saturday (Time-Workers).

(2) On Saturday in respect of :—

(a) That class of worker who customarily attends on Six Days a week :—

For all Overtime worked after the first five hours of work :—

- (i.) For the first four hours of Overtime, One-and-a-Half times the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Time-and-a-Half.
- (ii.) For Overtime after the first four hours of Overtime, Twice the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Double-Time.

NOTE.—During the first five hours worked on Saturday, the Minimum Rate applicable to the class of workers specified in paragraph (2) (a) is the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rate as set out in Part I. of this Notice.

Where Attendance on Five Days a Week only is Required.

(b) That class of worker who customarily attends on Five Days a week :—

- (i.) For the first two hours of Overtime (that is to say, for the first two hours worked on Saturday), One-and-a-Quarter times the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Time-and-a-Quarter.
- (ii.) For the second two hours of Overtime, One-and-a-Half times the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Time-and-a-Half.
- (iii.) For Overtime after the first four hours of Overtime, Twice the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable, *i.e.*, Double-Time.
