TRADE BOARDS ACTS, 1909 AND 1918.

LAUNDRY TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE WORKERS.

IN accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October 1918, the Trade Board established under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, for that branch of the trade specified in the Trade Boards (Laundry) Order, 1919, as varied by the Trade Boards (Women's Clothing) Order, 1919, the Trade Boards (Shirtmaking) Order, 1920, and the Trade Boards (Linen and Cotton Handkerchiefs and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods), Order, 1920, hereby give notice as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they propose to Vary the General Minimum Time-Rates and Overtime Rates at present fixed for certain classes of Male Workers, as set out in their Notice W. (3), dated 7th July 1920, as shown in the Schedule set out below.
