The KING has been graciously pleased to give directions for the following promotion in and appointment to the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George.

To be an Ordinary Member of the First Class, or Knights Grand Cross, of the said Most Distinguished Order:—

Sir Harold Arthur Stuart, K.C.S.I., K.C.M.G., K.C.V.O., British Representative on the Inter-Allied Plebiscite Commission in Upper Silesia.

To be an Ordinary Member of the Second Class, or Knights Commanders, of the said Most Distinguished Order:—

Major-General Sir William Charles Giffard Heneker, K.C.B., D.S.O., Commander of the British Upper Silesian Force.

TRADE BOARDS ACTS, 1909 AND 1918.

STAMPED OR PRESSED METAL WARES TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED) FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE WORKERS.

Effective as from 2nd September 1922.*

* Note.—Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages

are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates shall become effective as from the beginning of the next full pay period, but in no case later than 8th September 1922.

General Minimum Time-Rates.

For Male Workers other than workers who are employed as Braziers, Burnishers, Drop-Stampers, Dippers, Dippers who are also Bronzers, or as Annealers or Polishers:—

Male Workers of 21 years of age and over— 1s. 0d. per hour.

Male Workers under 21 years of age—According to age (see Section I. of Part I. of the Schedule below).

Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates.

15 per cent. above the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rates.

Overtime Rates.

See Section III. of Part I. of the Schedule below.
