The General Minimum Time-Rates set out in this Section are payable in the case of a worker under 24 years of age (other than a worker employed for seasonal work), subject to the proviso that such a worker is employed under conditions which in the circumstances of the case afford a reasonable prospect of advancement to the General Minimum Time-Rate of 50s. per week of 48 hours during the period of three months from the date on which the proposed variation takes effect (and 48s. per week of 48 hours as from the termination of that period of three months). Otherwise the General Minimum Time-Rate payable shall be 50s per week of 48 hours during the said period of three months (and 48s. per week of 48 hours as from the termination of the said period of three months) irrespective of age.

In the case of a worker employed for seasonal work, the General Minimum Time-Rate payable shall be that applicable according to the worker's age.

(1) The General Minimum Time-Rates set out in this Section are payable in the case of a worker under 18 years of age (other than a worker employed for seasonal work), subject to the proviso that such a worker is employed under conditions which in the circumstances of the case afford a reasonable prospect of advancement to the General Minimum Time-Rate of 27s. per week of 48 hours. Otherwise the General Minimum Time-Rate payable shall be 27s. per week of 48 hours, irrespective of age.

In the case of a worker employed for seasonal work, the General Minimum Time-Rate

payable shall be that applicable according to the worker's age.

(2) In the case of a worker (other than a worker employed for seasonal work) who enters the trade for the first time at the age of 15 years or over and who cannot suitably be employed on piecework the Proposed General Minimum Time-Rate payable during her first three months of employment in the trade shall be 3s, per week less than the Proposed General Minimum Time-Rate which would otherwise be applicable, and during her second three months of employment in the trade shall be 1s. 6d. per week less than the Proposed General Minimum Time-Rate which would otherwise be applicable, in accordance with the provisions of this Section.
