The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Scottish Education Department have, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts, 1919 and 1922, framed a Scheme further amending the Superannuation Scheme for Teachers in Scotland, dated the 5th day of June 1919, and approved by His Majesty in Council on the 30th day of July 1919 (S.R. & O., 1919, No. 1105):

And whereas the said amending Scheme has been laid before each House of Parliament in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts and neither House has presented an Address praying His Majesty to withhold His assent from the said amending Scheme, or any part thereof:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, having taken the said amending Scheme (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed) into consideration, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve the same and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the said amending Scheme shall take effect as from the first day of June 1922, with the exception that Article 23 (1), (2) and (3) thereof shall take effect as from the 16th day of May 1923.

SCHEME REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING ORDER IN COUNCIL.

AMENDMENT (1923) OF THE SUPERANNUATION SCHEME FOR TEACHERS UNDER THE EDUCATION (SCOTLAND) (SUPERANNUATION) ACTS, 1919 AND 1922.

Whereas by Section 1 of the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Act, 1919, it is enacted that the Department shall frame a superannuation scheme applicable to such teachers as shall be prescribed therein, and by Section 8 of the said Act certain procedure is prescribed with a view to the approval of a scheme so framed and of any amending scheme:

And whereas the fifth day of June 1919 the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them as aforesaid, framed a scheme (hereinafter called "the Scheme") which, after due fulfilment of the prescribed procedure, received approval by Order in Council, dated the thirtieth day of July 1919, and came into effect:

And whereas the Scheme was amended by a subsequent scheme made by the Department and approved in like manner by Order in Council, dated the twenty-first day of April 1922 (S.R. & O., 1922, No. 466):

And whereas by Section 2 of the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Act, 1922, it is enacted that the Department shall frame an amending scheme which shall provide for certain matters, and may provide for other matters, all arising out of the said Act and specified in the said Section:
