Parish of Clackmannan—

Road from the Water House (Reservoir) through Long Loan Plantation to the Saw Mill; Road from Russell Place, Clackmannan, by way of Woollen Mill to the Fauld Road; Road from Main Street, Clackmannan, by way of Pitmuir to Forest Mill Station; Road from Redyett to Fearn.

Parish of Dollar—

Road from Whitehillhead by way of Dollarbank to the boundary of the Burgh of Dollar; Road from Whitehillhead to the Quarrel Burn at the boundary of the Burgh of Dollar; Road from the Tillicoultry and Dollar Road near Harvistoun Villa by way of Lower Sheardale to Sheardale Braes.

Parish of Tillicoultry—

Road from the Dollar Road by way of Harvistoun Castle and Whitehillhead to the eastern boundary of the parish; Road from Whitehillhead to Dollar.

In the County of Stirling—

Parish of Airth—

Road from Scotston to Dunmore Pottery; Road from the Stirling and Grangemouth Road where it crosses the South Alloa Branch of the London Midland and Scottish Railway to South Alloa; Road from South Alloa by way of Dunmore to the road from Airth Castle to the river; Road from Airth to the Pier; Road from the Manse to Airth Castle and thence to Crooklandgate; Road from Keith Arms Inn by way of Pocknane to the southern boundary of the parish; Road from Greendyke to the Hydraulic Ram; Road from Langdyke Road to Letham Village to the public road at Letham Farm.

Parish of Logie—

Pendreich Road from Pendreich to Pendreich Mill; Road from the Sheriffmuir Road to Pendreich Road at Com-monty Wood; Path from Sheriffmuir Road to Lipney and thence to Blairlogie; Road from Bridge of Allan to Logie Church; Road from Crossroad Cottages to Craigmill; Road from Cornton Road to Allan Water.

Parish of St. Ninians—

Road from the Stirling Water Works to Cambusbarron Road; Road through Woodside from the last-mentioned road to Touchdam Road; Road from Westcarse across Dumbarton and Stirling Road to the western boundary of the parish; Road joining Stirling—Denny Road with Stirling—West Plean Road; Road from Forthbank along the north of Forthbank Carpet Works to the boundary of the Municipal Burgh of Stirling; Road in front of Forthbank Carpet Works to the north building line of Springfield Place; Road from Fallin by way of Drypow to the Grangemouth Road; Road from Ford at Wester Craigend to Gateside; Road from Gateside to Muirpark; Road from Stirling—Falkirk Road at East Gartclush to West Plean; Road from Scotston to the Grangemouth Road; Road from Bannockburn to Cat Craig and footpath thereafter to Corbie Wood; Road from Bannockburn by way of Newlands and also the road by way of Bogend to Corbie Wood near Muirside; Road from Bogend to Taits Close; Road from the Old Shaft near Corbie Wood to West Gartclush; Road from Muirdalehouse to last-mentioned road; Road from Scotston to Dunmore Pottery; Road from Plean Smithy to Powswood Cottage.

Parish of Abercorn—

Newton Road from the Stoneyhill Reservoir by way of Newton and Tottlywells to the boundary of the parish near Swineburn; Road from the Lodge at the south-eastern entrance to Hope-toun in an easterly direction to its junction with the road from Queensferry to Society near the eastern boundary of the parish; Road from the Linlithgow and Queensferry Road by way of Priestinch to the Union Canal at the boundary of the parish; Road from Whitequarries and Duntarvie Road by way of Craigton Hill to the Whitequarries and Craigton Road at Craigton.

Parish of Dalmeny—

Road from Dalmeny to a point in the road leading from Queensferry to Kirkliston and under the bridges carrying the London and North Eastern Railway (South Queensferry Branch and Forth Bridge Section); Road from Sentry Knowe to Slaughterhouse at boundary of the Municipal Burgh of Queensferry; Shore Road from the eastern boundary of the Municipal Burgh of Queensferry by way of Long Craig Gate to Long Craig Pier; Dolphington Road from Easter Dalmeny in a southerly direction across the Dolphington Burn to Dolphington Cottages; Road from the Quarry near Dolphington House by way of Dolphington and Dolphington Cottages to its junction with the road from Dal-
