COUNTY COUNCIL ELECTORAL
DIVISIONS OF PERTH.

Whereas the contents and boundaries of the Electoral Divisions of Errol and Inchtute, in the County of Perth, were determined by an Order under the hands and common seal of the Boundary Commissioners for Scotland dated the 3rd August 1891;

And whereas the County Council of the County of Perth have represented to me that it

is desirable to alter the contents and boundaries of the Electoral Divisions of Errol and Inchtute;

And whereas I am of opinion that it is expedient to give effect to the representation of the County Council;

Now therefore, I, the undersigned, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, in virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 51 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, do hereby order as follows:

The Errol and Inchtute Electoral Divisions as defined by the said Order of the Boundary Commissioners for Scotland, dated the 3rd August 1891, shall from and after this date have the following description and contents:—

Name of Division.	Contents of Division.
Errol	The Parish of Errol.
Inchtute	(1) The Parish of Inchtute; (2) the Parish of Abernyte; (3) the Parish of Kinnaird.
