**WHEREAS** by the Representation of the People Acts, 1918 to 1922, power is conferred upon His Majesty to make provision for various matters by Order in Council:

And whereas by the Representation of the People Order His Majesty was pleased by Order in Council to make provision for various matters under those Acts:

And whereas by Section 40 (2) of the Representation of the People Act, 1918, any

Order in Council made thereunder may be revoked or varied as occasion requires by any subsequent Order in Council:

And whereas it is expedient that the Representation of the People Order should be amended in manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon Him by those Acts and of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The following forms of claim to be registered shall be substituted for the forms numbered (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) (6) (7) and (8) under Heading II. in Schedule I. to the Representation of the People Order:—
