ORDER OF THE BOARD OF TRADE, DATED JANUARY 1, 1925, UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920 (10 & 11 GEO. 5, C. 28), PRESCRIBING THE RATE OF CONTRIBUTION TO THE GAS FUND FOR THE YEAR. 1925.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 7 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, the Board of Trade hereby prescribe that:—

1. The rate of contribution to the Gas Fund for the year 1925 shall be one shilling and threepence for each million cubic feet of gas sold during the year 1924.

2. Such contribution shall, on or before the

1st April 1925 be paid to the Board of Trade at Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, by any Gas Undertakers with respect to whom an order under the said Act shall have been made, by cheque made payable to the "Assistant Secretary for Finance, Board of Trade," and crossed "Gas Fund Account."
