

CAITHNESS COUNTY COUNCIL.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 22nd day of August 1925 the County Council of the County of Caithness as Local Authority within the said County passed the following Resolution, namely:—

"The County Council of Caithness as Local Authority in said County having met after twenty-one clear days' notice by advertisement in the Edinburgh Gazette and local papers, and considered the propriety of forming the Village of HALKIRK into a SPECIAL WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT, hereby resolve to form and hereby form under Section 131 of the Public Health (Scotland) Act, 1897, the following part of their District into a Special Water Supply District, namely:—The Village of Halkirk being (1) the subjects lying to the south of the Thurso River bounded on the north by the said River commencing at a point marked "A" on the Plan hereinafter referred to, 190 lineal yards or thereby west of Halkirk Bridge and running in an easterly direction by an irregular line along the bank of said River to the point marked "B" on said Plan 900 lineal yards or thereby east of said Bridge. On the East commencing at the said point "B" and running first in a south-easterly direction to the County Road leading to Hoy at the point marked "C" on said Plan, a distance of 193 lineal yards or thereby, thence in a south-westerly direction along said Public Road a distance of 347 lineal yards or thereby to the point marked "D" on said Plan, thence by an irregular line generally in a southerly direction a distance of 1210 lineal yards or thereby to a point on the London Midland and Scottish Railway line at a point marked "E" on said Plan. On the South commencing at the point "E" last mentioned and running in a westerly direction along the said Railway line a distance of 650 lineal yards or thereby to a point marked "F" on said Plan 133 lineal yards or thereby west of the County Road where it crosses said Railway line. On the West commencing at a point "F" last mentioned and running generally in a northerly direction by an irregular line a distance of 1453 lineal yards or thereby to the point "A" first mentioned, and (2) the subjects lying to the north of the said River bounded as follows:—Commencing at the point marked "G" on said Plan on the Gerston Road and running in an easterly direction a distance of 50 lineal yards or thereby to the junction of the last-mentioned road with public road leading to Thurso, thence in a southerly direction along the last-mentioned road a distance of 83 lineal yards or thereby and thence in an easterly direction a distance of 140 lineal yards or thereby to the point marked "H" on said Plan. thence in a southerly direction a distance of 150 lineal yards or thereby to the point marked "J" on said Plan on the road leading to Brawl Castle, thence in a westerly direction along the last-mentioned road to a junction with the said road leading to Thurso a distance of 160 lineal yards or thereby, thence in a southerly direction along the last-mentioned road a distance of 66 yards or thereby to a point 25 yards or thereby north of the centre of Halkirk Bridge, thence in a westerly direction a distance of 116 lineal yards or thereby to the point marked "K" on said Plan and thence by an irregular line generally in a northerly direction a distance of 340 lineal yards or thereby to the point "G" above mentioned; all as delineated and shown within the boundaries coloured red on a Plan dated 20th June 1925, prepared by Messrs. Geo. Gordon & Coy., Civil Engineers, Inverness, and signed by the Chairman of this Meeting as relative hereto.

WESTERN DISTRICT COMMITTEE.
