SHEEP SCAB MOVEMENT AREAS.

The following Areas in Scotland are now "Movement Areas" for the purposes of Part I. of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920:—

*Inverness*.—(1) An Area comprising the Islands known as the Outer Hebrides (except the islands of *St. Kilda, Dune, Soay, and Boreraay*), in the county of Inverness.

(2) An Area in the county of Inverness

comprising the islands known as Skye or Inner Hebrides.

*Ross and Cromarty*.—An Area comprising the Island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
